Master Fundamental Stitches

Preparing Your Tools & Setup

- Choose a beginner-friendly hoop: wood or basic round hoop with good tension
- Select tightly woven, washable fabrics like cotton or linen
- Use quality needles and manageable thread lengths

Stitching Clean & Even Work

- Maintain even tension on fabric and thread
- Stabilize fabric when needed; iron out wrinkles before stitching
- Keep workspace well lit, comfortable, and organized

Practice & Progress Tracking

- Create sampler projects for different stitches
- Track small projects: daily or weekly practice with small pieces
- Rotate between projects to build skill and confidence
