

5 Interior Layout Mistakes Americans Make (And How to Fix Them)

Avoid Oversized Furniture in Small Rooms

- Measure your space before buying large pieces
- Choose slim profile furniture or pieces that double as storage

Correct TV Placement

- Center screens at seated eye level
- Avoid glare: choose placement away from windows or use window covers

Utilize Dead Spaces & Unused Corners

- Add small tables, lamps, or plants to unused corners
- Use rugs or furniture to define purpose in those areas

Improve Lighting Design

- Mix ambient, task, and accent lighting
- Avoid harsh overhead lighting alone

Ensure Clear Paths & Traffic Flow

- Leave at least 30-36 inches for walkways
- Avoid blocking natural movement with furniture
